## \*\*\*YOU WILL NEED THE POC NUMBER AT THE TOP OF THIS LETTER IN ORDER TO FILE AN OBJECTION\*\*\*

Although a final Court determination fixes the class and value for your POC, because IICRRG is insolvent, the amount ultimately paid will be equal to a pro rata share of the determined value. EVEN IF YOUR CLAIM HAS A VALUE GREATER THAN ZERO, YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE THAT FULL VALUE. IICRRG is insolvent; there are not enough funds in the estate to pay all claims. The amount ultimately paid for each claim will be reduced by an equal percentage of the value for each class. This percentage will be applied to all claims in a class at the same time, after all claims have been considered. No claim will be paid until after all claim values have been finally determined by the Court and after later application to the Court by the Receiver for final distribution of IICRRG's assets. THIS MEANS THAT REGARDLESS OF YOUR GROUP, ALL MEMBERS OF A CLASS WILL RECEIVE THE SAME PRO RATA VALUE OF THEIR FINALLY DETERMINED CLAIMS AND WILL BE PAID AT THE SAME TIME.
